Volunteer Opportunities!

Pre Walk

Marketing:

Volunteers assist in awareness activities from early-August to the week of the event by putting up posters and banners in the Calgary area. Volunteers will also visit various pre-determined sites to distribute pledge forms.

Drivers:

Volunteers pick up supplies the week prior to the walk, and deliver them to the walk site on event day.

Event Day

Set up:

Volunteers assist in setting up tables, unloading supplies and distributing them to the tents at the event site.

Route Volunteer:

Volunteers assist in route set up including water stations and signage, and provide direction and assistance to walkers while cheering them on!

Food and Beverage:

Volunteers assist in setting up the food and beverage tent and in distributing snacks and water to walkers.
