

Pride Festival

Supervisor: Coordinator of Volunteer Engagement

Level: Volunteers for the Pride Festival are ranked at a **Tier 1 position** (See brochure for details)

Position Description: Volunteers walk alongside AIDS Calgary staff at the Pride Parade and distribute safer sex supplies and awareness raising information.

Objective: Walking in the parade allows AIDS Calgary to promote our work to the community. The distribution of safer sex supplies contributes to AIDS Calgary's mission of reducing the harm associated with HIV for all individuals and communities in the Calgary region.

Time Commitment:

- Must be available for 2 to 3 hours on the day of the Pride Parade. The parade is held at the beginning of September.

Responsibilities:

- Submit your name to the Coordinator of Volunteer Engagement to walk in the Parade with AIDS Calgary
- Arrive at the time and location indicated and collect your supplies
- Walk with staff and other volunteers and hand out supplies to people lined up along the route

Qualifications:

- Support for the mission and philosophies of AIDS Calgary
- Outgoing
- Willing to walk in the Parade regardless of weather conditions

Training:

- None required

- Opportunity to be involved in community based work and meet new people
- A fun event to attend
- Receive the AIDS Calgary newsletter
