

Volunteer Activity Nights

Supervisor: Coordinator of Volunteer Engagement

Level: Volunteers taking part in activity nights are ranked at a **Tier 1 position** (See brochure for details)

Position Description: Approximately 12 to 15 volunteers gather once a month to complete tasks such as creating condom packs, helping with agency mail-outs, making AIDS ribbons and assisting with other simple tasks.

Objective: Activity nights allow us to complete a large number of small tasks in one sitting, as a group, in a fun and relaxed environment.

Time Commitment:

- Must be available for 2 to 3 hours on activity nights. Some daytime opportunities may become available (dates to be announced).

Responsibilities:

- Register your name once the dates are announced
- Arrive at the office at time indicated and assist with the tasks that are planned. Eg – making condom packs or ribbons
- If you are registered and can not attend, call the Coordinator of Volunteer Engagement to cancel

Qualifications:

- Willing to assist with miscellaneous tasks
- Support for the mission and philosophies of AIDS Calgary

- Hands on training
