Supervisor: Volunteer Coordinator

Level: Marketing is ranked as a **Tier 1 position** (See brochure for details).

Position Description: Volunteers assist with the distribution of posters, brochures and other marketing materials in the Calgary area.

Objective: The distribution of AIDS Calgary materials assists the agency in raising awareness and educating the community about HIV as a global and local issue.

Time Commitment:

- Flexible and dependant on need throughout the year. On average one shift would be 3 to 4 hours.

Responsibilities:

- Register with the Volunteer Coordinator as a Marketing Volunteer
- When opportunities arise, the Coordinator will contact you with the details of when and where the materials need to be distributed. For example, prior to the AIDS Walk for Life posters are handed out to businesses and schools throughout the city.
- Pick up the materials at the AIDS Calgary office and distribute them as indicated
- Return any remaining materials to the AIDS Calgary office

Qualifications:

- Access to a car or public transit
- Outgoing and friendly
- Ability to approach strangers

Benefits:

- Excellent opportunity to attend fun events throughout the year (eg – summer festivals)
- Practice communication and networking skills
- Receive recognition from AIDS Calgary and others for your support
- Increase understanding of HIV/AIDS in your community
- Be a part of a global movement
