



## Scotiabank AIDS Walk for Life: Event Day

**Supervisor:** Volunteer Coordinator

**Level:** AIDS Walk for Life event day positions are ranked at a **Tier 1 position** (See brochure for details).

**Position Description:** Volunteers have the opportunity to take on various roles prior to the event by sitting on the planning committee (see specific position descriptions for committee members) or by helping to execute the event on Walk day, September 20, 2009. Approximately 60 – 70 volunteers assist on event day each year.

**Objective:** Every year, hundreds of Calgarians walk, run, bike, and rollerblade in support of the fight against HIV/AIDS. Funds raised from the walk help provide services to people living with HIV/AIDS in Calgary, as well as support HIV/AIDS prevention and education initiatives in your community.

**Time Commitment:**

- Volunteers will commit to a 4 to 6 hour shift on Walk day, September 20, 2009

**Responsibilities:**

- Contact the Volunteer Coordinator for an application form and up to date list of opportunities once the recruitment announcement is made (approx 6 weeks prior to the event)
- Fill out the application form and choose your favorite position, such as Registration team, Food and Beverage team or Route Marshall
- Wait for Volunteer Coordinator to contact you with a confirmation of your position and any details you will need to know for Walk day
- Attend training if required
- Arrive on time on Walk day for your shift as indicated

**Qualifications:**

- Anyone can join us as an event day volunteer for the Scotiabank AIDS Walk for Life
