Supervisor: Volunteer Coordinator

Level: Volunteers for the Casino are ranked at a **Tier 2 position** (See brochure for details).

Position Description: Volunteers take on various positions to assist with running AIDS Calgary's Casino.

Objective: To raise funds to support AIDS Calgary's work.

Time Commitment:

- Our Casino nights are held once every 18 months, over a 2 day period
- Volunteers will need to be available for an 8 hour shift, during the day or night (times vary)

Responsibilities:

- Submit your name to the Volunteer Coordinator to participate after the Casino dates are announced and fill out the application sent to you
- Arrive on time to the location indicated
- Positions vary. Follow the instructions and training provided by Casino staff and the advisor based on the position given to you

Qualifications:

- Comfort working in a Casino environment
- Ability to work an 8 hour shift

Training:

- Hands on, simple training given onsite

Benefits:

- Opportunity to meet new people
- A free meal at the Casino
- Receive the AIDS Calgary newsletter and Volunteer newsletter

Application Requirements:

- Register with the Volunteer Coordinator
- Complete a Casino Volunteer form, which includes a Security Clearance Check
- Sign an Oath of Confidentiality agreement
